Inspect illegal encampments for rodent infestation, garbage and general sanitation to gain cleanup and removal of encampments. Prepare letters and notices of violation to effect abatement of a nuisance or hazard. Coordinate activities with building inspection agencies, police department and other public agencies. Obtain inspection warrant, draw up settlement agreement, file criminal complaints and appear in court to testify when necessary.
