1                   AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive  
2                   to execute an interlocal agreement with the city of Kent for  
3                   the transfer of drainage parcels adjacent to Southeast 240th  
4                   Street in the city of Kent.

6                   STATEMENT OF THE FACTS:

7                   1. The city of Kent entered into an interlocal agreement for improvements  
8                   to Southeast 240th Street on May 5, 1996. King County acquired  
9                   properties for use as drainage facilities in connection with these  
10                  improvements. The properties are King County tax parcels 162205-9127  
11                  and 222205-9009. The drainage parcels are critical to the integrity of the  
12                  road.

13                  2. The city of Kent annexed parcel 162205-9127 as part of the DeMarco  
14                  annexation, effective June 27, 2001. The city of Kent annexed parcel  
15                  222205-9009 as part of the Meridian Valley annexation, effective July 1,  
16                  1997.

17           3. King County wishes to transfer the parcels to the city of Kent to ensure  
18           maintenance of the properties in their natural condition as a reserve for  
19           future use, or if necessary, for drainage-related repairs or other purposes  
20           related to the maintenance and operation of the adjacent road. The city  
21           wishes to accept ownership of the parcels.

22           4. RCW 39.34 authorizes the county and the city to enter into an  
23           interlocal cooperation agreement in the form of Attachment A to this  
24           ordinance.

25           BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

26           SECTION 1. The county executive is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal
