NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

Pursuant to its authority under RCW 70.05.060, the King County Board of Health hereby gives notice of proposed rulemaking to amend certain Board of Health Code provisions governing fees for Environmental Health permits provided by Public Health – Seattle and King County for Fiscal Years 2010 and beyond. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to establish fees for Environmental Health inspections and evaluations of public water systems and for review of on-site sewage system design applications and building remodel permit applications in order to attain full cost recovery for services required to assure a safe and adequate potable water supply.

A public hearing on the proposed rule at which the public may state their views orally or in writing will be held during the regular meeting of the King County Board of Health, September 17, 2009, 1:30 p.m. in the Metropolitan King County Council Chambers, 10th floor, Courthouse, 516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA.
