

## To our customers: A few words about requesting Property-Related Environmental Public Records

King County's property-related environmental records are among the most often requested records of county government. A table of the most often sought categories of environmental records appears below, with notations for each. Rest assured that any requests made through the King County Executive Branch's Public Records Program will be coordinated among all King County Executive Branch departments and workgroups likely to have responsive records. A single request through this program will be coordinated through the following workgroups as appropriate to ensure a thorough and timely response. The request form is attached. There is no value in making individual requests to the organizations listed immediately below, as they are included in the coordinated response.
