SUBJECT: Airport to use new Emergency Notification System

On September 25, King County International Airport will begin using Everbridge Communications to provide routine and emergency information to airport users, including pilots, tenants, and the general public. Everbridge provides an efficient and dependable email, text, and phone system for distributing timely alerts. This system will replace our current airport advisory email system.

To continue receiving KBFI Airport Advisories, each subscriber must create an account on the Everbridge member portal. Current subscribers will receive an email this week with registration instructions. The email will come from KBFI.notifications@kingcounty.gov. Be sure to add this email to your "safe" email list. Your subscriber information will remain confidential and will only be used for communications from King County International Airport.
