

**Comments Relating to Reclaimed Water Comprehensive Plan Reclaimed Water Strategies Paper
E&P Subcommittee Meeting
January 19, 2010**

Comment	Revision to Paper Submitted to Executive
<i>There was a suggestion the name of the Redmond/Bear Creek Basin Centralized Strategy should reflect that it is an expansion of the Brightwater Reclaimed Water System.</i>	Where strategies include an expansion of existing reclaimed water facility at regional treatment plant the strategy names will be revised to include the treatment plant name.
<i>There was a suggestion that the name of the Renton/Tukwila Centralized Strategy should reflect that it is an expansion of South Treatment Plant Reclaimed Water System.</i>	
<i>It would be helpful to show which uses are seasonal and which are annual in the paper.</i>	Strategy fact sheets and legends on strategy maps will include information on which uses are assumed seasonal and which are year round.
<i>The assumption on the duration (annual or seasonal) of potential reclaimed water environmental enhancements uses should be included in the paper.</i>	A note will be added to the fact sheet on the map that states the assumption of year round environmental enhancement use is based on preliminary analysis and the number of months per year a potential use could occur is subject to further analysis. Additional discussion of what parameters were included in preliminary analysis will be added to the paper.
<i>Include the reasoning behind the up to .5 MGD capacity assumption for the Reclaimed Water Skimming or Polishing Strategy in the paper.</i>	The report will note that the strategy seeks to locate a reclaimed water treatment plant and potential use near existing regional wastewater conveyance line in order to minimize reclaimed water distribution pipe.
<i>Include the basis for the less than 1 mile of reclaimed water distribution pipe in the Reclaimed Water Skimming or Polishing Strategy in the paper.</i>	
<i>It would be helpful to point out how all the strategies relate or do not relate to the comprehensive plan drivers in the paper.</i>	The paper will include text that the drivers were considered during development of the strategies and if strategies are approved for analysis the approved evaluation criteria will be used to assess how the strategies address the drivers.
<i>It would also be helpful to point out how the proposed strategies for analysis relate to the comprehensive plan drivers.</i>	
<i>Expand on the regulatory challenges that are referred to in the strategies not being proposed for further analysis.</i>	Text will be added to the paper that states regulatory uncertainties included water quality standards for direct flow augmentation and the use of reclaimed water to mitigate water withdrawals.
