Free Training!

Throughout the year the public serving systems will provide training to introduce social services personnel and families to the different systems serving adults. The aim of the training is to give individuals an understanding of:

- Who each system serves,
- The eligibility criteria for each system,
- The range of available programs,
- How to refer your client in the various serving systems,
- Who to contact at those resources if you are having difficulty with the services offered.

The systems presenting at this training are: public assistance, juvenile justice, family resources, public health, alcohol and drug abuse services, developmental disabilities, home and community services, vocational resources, involuntary treatment, and mental health treatment services.
