

## 2011 RYAN WHITE Funded Programs

### Eligibility for use of Ryan White Part A funds:

Individual clients are eligible for Ryan White-funded services if they:

- Are living with HIV;
- Have an annual household income at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Level (300% of FPL for case management services)
- Are residents of the Seattle Transition Grant Area (TGA): King, Snohomish or Island counties
- Receive services not covered by Medicaid or other insurance

Country Doctor	PLWH receiving primary care at Country Doctor

Consejo	Latino/a PLWH (esp. monolingual Spanish speakers)
Jail Health Services	Incarcerated PLWH
Evergreen AIDS Foundation	PLWH living in Snohomish and Island Counties

Country Doctor	Primary medical care

Harborview/Madison Clinic	Primary medical care; psychiatric care; medical nutrition therapy
Lifelong AIDS Alliance	Housing search/referral and emergency vouchers; food/meals; substance abuse counseling; medical nutrition therapy
Neighborcare Health	Dental care
Jail Health Services	Mental health counseling
Public Health/Opiate Replacement Treatment	Methadone vouchers
Rosehedge Multifaith Works	Multifaith Works: Independent group housing Rosehedge: Assisted living residential housing
