

Free H1N1 Clinics for Children in April

Children under the age of 10 need a second H1N1 flu vaccination. They must wait 28 days or longer before getting their second dose.

In April, Public Health will offer additional clinics for children who need to get their second vaccination. These walk-in clinics will be free. You will **not** be asked for proof of health insurance or citizenship.
