### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

#### Directions from I-5 heading North:

TAKE Exit 168A and bear left (North) onto Lakeview Blvd E.  
Turn RIGHT onto Harvard Avenue  
Turn RIGHT onto Boston  
Turn RIGHT onto 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue E.

#### Directions from I-5 heading South:

TAKE Exit 168A and continue South on Boylston Ave E.  
Turn LEFT onto E. Roanoke St.  
Turn RIGHT onto 10<sup>th</sup> Ave E.
