

## **VI. Parks and Trails**

### *Parks*

[Cottage Lake Park](#) is located at the northern part of Cottage Lake along NE Woodinville-Duvall Road near the intersection of Avondale Road NE. The nearly 21 acre park contains multiple services, including an amphitheater, picnic areas and shelters with barbeque pits, a multi-purpose court, and a local trail. A fishing pier and a non-motorized boat put-in area are also on site. The Cottage Lake Pool is an outdoor pool open during the summer months.

The [Cold Creek and Basset Pond](#) Natural Areas are located in the western part of the demonstration area. An additional portion of the Cold Creek Natural Area is also found west of the demonstration area. Together they comprise nearly 250 acres of wetlands, streams and springs that form important habitat for birds and other wildlife. Natural Areas are managed for their ecological value and allow only low-impact activities such as walking and nature observation.

Northeast of the demonstration area is the Paradise Lake Natural Area. Directly to the east are the Upper and Middle Bear Creek Natural Areas.

### *Trails*

The Tolt Pipeline Trail runs along the southern border of the demonstration area. Part of the regional trail system, it runs for approximately 14 miles between Bothell and Duvall and can be used by bicyclists, equestrians and hikers.

Additional trails within the demonstration area are in the Cold Creek Natural Area. These soft surface trails are located in the northern part of the Natural Area and are accessible from NE Woodinville-Duvall Road.
