

VI. Parks and Trails

Parks

There are two King County owned parks within the demonstration area. Both are undeveloped with no facilities on site.

[Maplewood Heights Park](#) is a 19 acre forested park south of Liberty High School. It is located at 168th Avenue SE and SE 140th Street. Although there are no recreational services on site, there are trails used by the residents.

The 22 acre [Cedar River to Lake Sammamish Trail](#) site is located in the northwest corner of the demonstration area at 156th Avenue SE and SE 128th Street. Currently undeveloped, this park is planned to be part of the Cedar River to Lake Sammamish Trail.

To the west of the demonstration area is the 45 acre [Maplewood Park](#). Numerous facilities are located on this park, including a multi-purpose court, playfield and picnic areas. [Coalfield Park](#) to the north provides additional facilities and recreational facilities on a 20 acre site. Ron Regis Park is southwest of the demonstration area at the lower elevation within the City of Renton.

[Cavanaugh Pond Natural Area](#) is located along the Cedar River directly south of the demonstration area and supports foot traffic from the Cedar River Trail and area residents.

Trails

There are no official trails within the demonstration area. The undeveloped Maplewood Heights Park does have trails through it that are used by the residents. The Cedar River to Lake Sammamish Trail has a site located in the northwestern corner of the demonstration area, but this site is still undeveloped. The closest official trail is the [Cedar River](#) trail along the Cedar River south of the demonstration area.
