

## Defeated Annexation

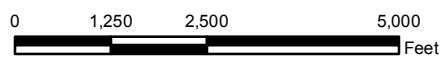
**City:** Renton

**Annexation Name:** Fairwood

**Boundary Review Board File 2308. Defeated by voters on November 2, 2010 with an approval rate of 42.4%. The Fairwood annexation was 3,995 acres, and located to the south and east of Renton. The annexation area was formed on the south, in part, by the Kent/Renton PAA boundary. The remainder of the south and east boundary were formed by the UGB. The north and west boundary was formed by the existing city of Renton. The assessed value of the failed annexation is \$2.85 billion.**
