## 2011 Arterial Asphalt and Concrete Paving -Georgetown Streets-

May 2, 2011

### Construction to begin week of May 9<sup>th</sup>

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is repaving several streets in the Georgetown neighborhood. The project is funded by the **Bridging the Gap** transportation initiative approved by Seattle voters in 2006.

### SDOT will begin construction the week of May 9<sup>th</sup> on the following streets in Georgetown:

- **Ellis Avenue S** - E Marginal Way S to S Albro Place
- **S Albro Place** - Ellis Avenue S to Stanley Ave S
- **East Marginal Way S** - 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S to Ellis Avenue S

*Expect traffic lane closures and detours, as well as parking and load zone restrictions.*

- *On Ellis Avenue S there will be one lane open for traffic in each direction during the week, but on occasional weekends there will be intersection closures. There will be at least two weekends when northbound traffic is detoured.*
- *E Marginal Way S will be reduced to one lane in each direction except during afternoon peak commuting hours.*

*Construction will be completed on these streets by late June.*

### What to Expect During Construction

- Lane closures
- Traffic slowdowns
- Traffic detours
- Pedestrian detours
- Parking and loading restrictions
- Construction noise and dust
- Instances of weekday, weekend and night work
- Regular notices with more schedule and location specific information during construction

From late June through October 2011 construction will take place in the following locations:

- **East Marginal Way S** – Ellis Ave S to the Seattle city limits
- **Corson Ave S** - E Marginal Way S to S Michigan Street

A Georgetown neighborhood street, **Airport Way S from S Lucille Street to S Hardy Street**, will be paved as part of the Airport over Argo Bridge Rehabilitation project.
