

# Now Accepting Applications for Community Engagement Projects in the Unincorporated Community Service Areas

**Applications due  
December 8, 2014  
by 5 p.m.**

A total of \$60,000\* will be reimbursed for projects in 2015. Amounts will be limited to less than \$5,000 per project.

A minimum match of 25% of the total project cost is required. Match can be in the form of volunteer time, cash or other forms of in-kind services and other resources from project partners and contributors.

The purpose of the Community Engagement Grants is to fund community projects that offer unincorporated area residents in the Community Service Areas an opportunity to participate and be more connected in their communities.
