Ballard Siphon Replacement Project Update – Puget Sound Energy work begins at the South Site

Puget Sound Energy (PSE) will be working in West Commodore Way near 24th Avenue West the **week of March 19**. *Puget Sound Energy (PSE) estará trabajando en West Commodore Way cerca de 24th Avenue West la semana del 19 de marzo.*

This work is to relocate utilities in preparation for installation of a junction structure connecting the new siphon to the existing conveyance system. The work is anticipated to be completed by Friday, March 23.

Traffic will be temporarily reduced to one lane on West Commodore Way and 24th Avenue West during this work and there will be some temporary parking restrictions. *Please use caution in this area and follow posted traffic signs and flaggers.*

What to expect at the South Site:

- Periodic traffic revisions on West Commodore Way near the 24th Avenue West intersection
- High levels of activity involving crews, cranes, excavation equipment and trucks
- Increased truck traffic on and around West Commodore Way
- Possible work on Saturdays and/or longer work hours during the week
