Shoring will be removed in West Commodore Way beginning September 24; near neighbors may experience vibration

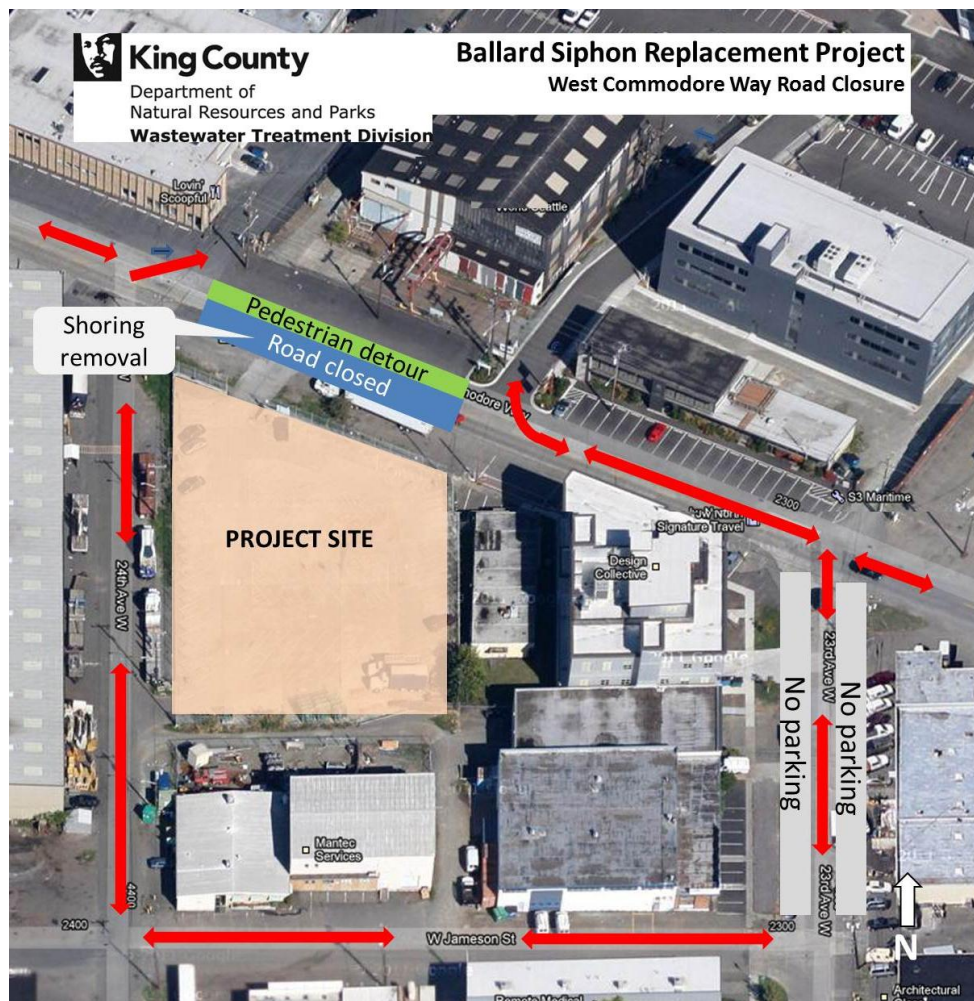
*Comenzarán a remover secciones de acero apuntalar en Comodoro de Oeste el 24 de septiembre.

Beginning Monday, September 24, crews will remove the shoring installed for the junction structure construction from West Commodore Way. **Near neighbors may experience vibration from this work.** Crews expect to remove the majority of the shoring by Thursday, September 27. Additional work to remove shoring may be required the week of October 1.

Once shoring is removed, West Commodore Way will be repaired and reopened by mid-October.

WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE SOUTH SITE:

- Vibration the week of September 24; possible vibration the week of October 1
- West Commodore Way road closure and detour
- High levels of activity involving crews, excavation equipment and trucks
- Increased truck traffic on and around West Commodore Way
- Typical work hours Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. until 6 p.m.; longer weekday hours and Saturday work possible
