North Site Project Update – September 28, 2012 *(see reverse for South Site)*

North site: More noise and possible vibration during first two weeks of October as crews begin work to connect the new siphon to the existing sewer system.

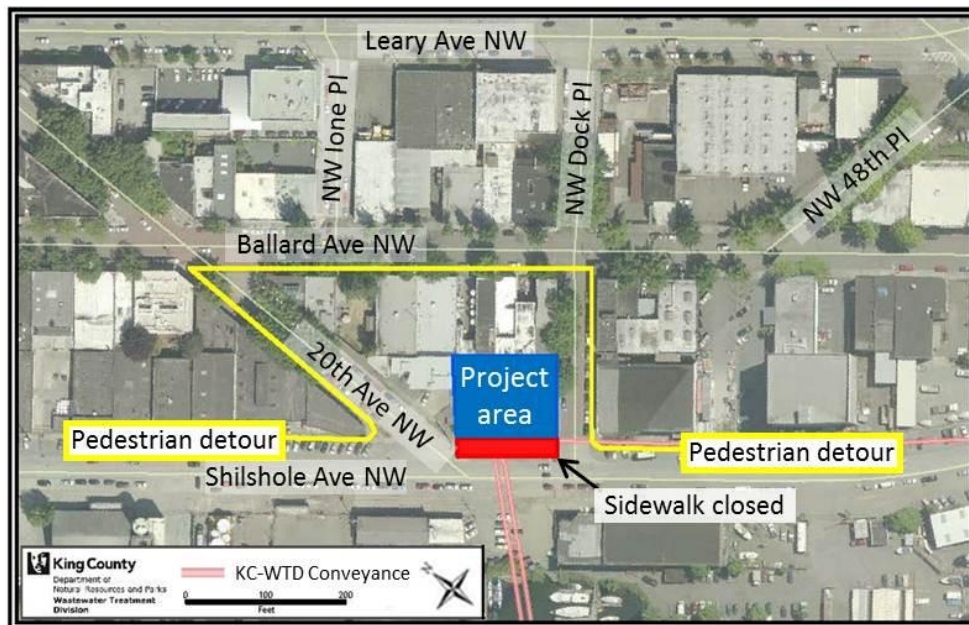

NORTH SITE ACTIVITIES:

Crews are resuming work on the north site and will begin building the structure that will connect the existing sewer pipes to the new siphon pipeline. Crews will begin installing shoring during the week of October 1. **This work may be noisy and near neighbors may experience some vibration. This work is anticipated to last two weeks.** Once shoring is installed, crews will begin excavation.

Construction fencing in front of the project site on Shilshole Avenue Northwest is now back closer to the street to accommodate the work.

King County urges drivers and bicyclists to continue to use caution near the site. Pedestrians in Ballard should follow sidewalk detour signs around the north site.



WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE NORTH SITE:

- High levels of activity involving crews, cranes, excavation equipment and trucks
- More noise and possible vibration during the first two weeks of October
- Increased truck traffic on and around Shilshole Avenue Northwest
- Shilshole Avenue Northwest sidewalk remains closed in front of the project site

South site: Shoring removal has been completed. West Commodore Way will be repaired and reopened by mid-October.

SOUTH SITE ACTIVITIES:

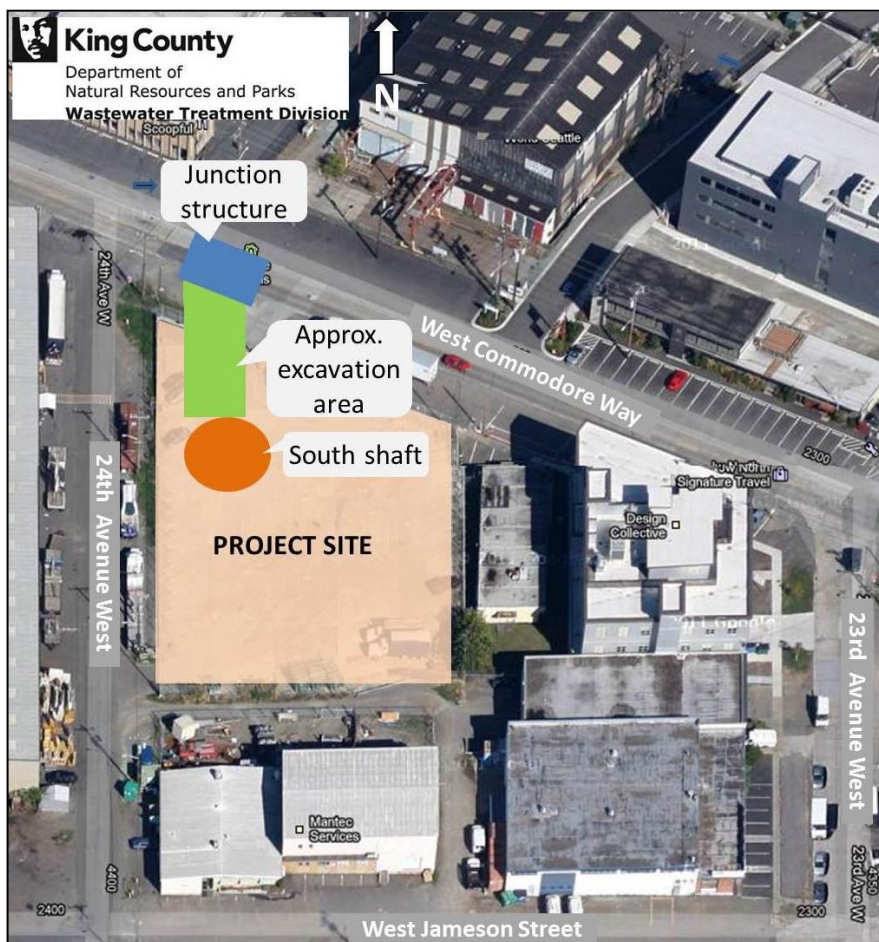
Crews have completed removing shoring from West Commodore Way. **Thank you for your patience during this work.** West Commodore Way will be repaired and reopened by mid-October.

Crews will continue constructing the pipe that connects the new siphon to the existing system. Crews will install shoring and excavate the area between the junction structure on West Commodore Way and the shaft on the project site (see map). Notice will be provided prior to shoring installation.

Community members can expect increased truck traffic around the project area as the tunnel boring machine and large, concrete rings to support excavation are delivered to the site. Tunneling is expected to begin in late October.

WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE SOUTH SITE:

- High levels of activity involving crews, cranes, excavation equipment and trucks
- Increased truck traffic on and around West Commodore Way
- West Commodore Way road closure and detour through mid-October
- Possible work on Saturdays and/or longer work hours during the week
