

Utility investigations on Shilshole Avenue Northwest January 23 and 24; Crews begin removing shoring at north project site January 25

*Investigaciones de utilidad en Shilshole Avenue Northwest el 23 y 24 de enero;
Comenzarán a remover secciones de acero apuntalar desde el sitio del norte el 25 de enero*

Crews will be digging small holes on the north and south sides of Shilshole Avenue Northwest to locate existing underground utilities. Work will occur on Wednesday and Thursday, January 23 and 24. Flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic through the construction area. The work is necessary to maintain utility services in the area during the relining of the 75-year old existing Ballard Siphon, which starts later this year.

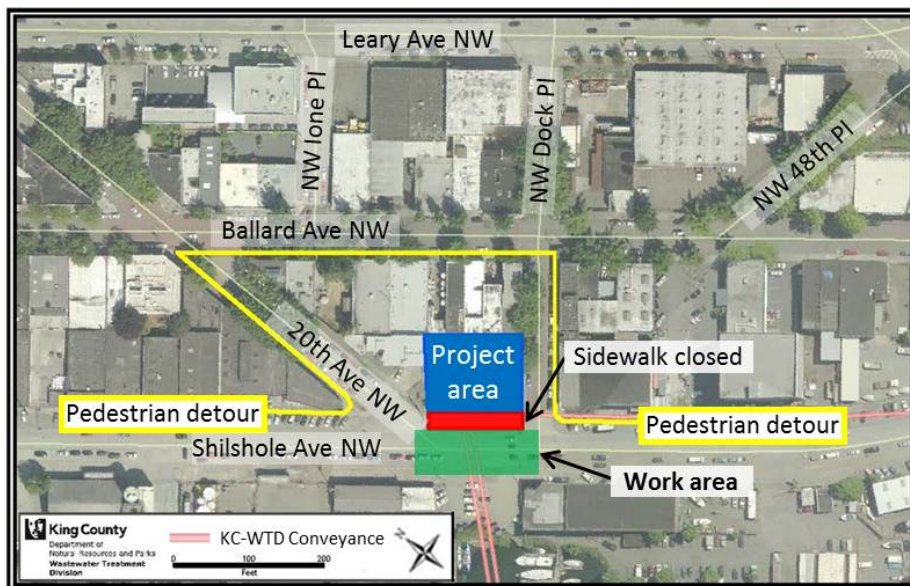
Crews continue to build the structure on the north site that will connect the existing sewer pipes to the new siphon pipeline. Beginning Friday, January 25, crews will begin removing shoring from the project area. **This work may be noisy and near neighbors may experience some vibration.**

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING UTILITY WORK:

- Flaggers on site to ease congestion
- Increased noise near the work area from the potholing equipment
- Work will occur from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday and Thursday, January 23 and 24
- The road will be restored according to the City of Seattle standards

WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE NORTH SITE:

- Possible noise and vibration
January 25 through January 31
- High levels of activity involving crews, cranes, excavation equipment and trucks
- Increased truck traffic on and around Shilshole Avenue Northwest
- Shilshole Avenue Northwest sidewalk remains closed in front of the project site



Utility investigation work will occur on the north and south sides of Shilshole Avenue Northwest directly south of the project area
