BELLEVUE PUMP STATION UPGRADE WINTER 2010

Project Update: March 8, 2010

Starting the week of Monday, March 8 crews will begin installing steel decking and roof trusses for the new pump station building. Crews will also begin pouring the concrete slab for the foundation of the new chemical building.

The temporary pump station system will continue to provide wastewater service to the community while construction progresses on the upgraded pump station.

What to expect

- Increased truck activity and noise coming from the site starting the week of **Monday, March 8 through Wednesday, March 17.**
- Construction activities typically will occur weekdays between 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Neighbors will be given advance notice of any construction activities that may require extended work hours.

King County is upgrading the Bellevue Pump Station to protect public health and the environment. The existing pump station is more than 40 years old and must be expanded to accommodate Bellevue's growing wastewater treatment needs.
