


# BELLEVUE FORCE MAIN INSTALLATION PROJECT

Surveying work to occur on this property during weeks of July 9 and July 16

To protect public health and the environment, King County will build a new wastewater force main to connect the Bellevue Pump Station to a regional pipeline east of I-405 that transports wastewater to King County's wastewater treatment plant in Renton.

The new 5,300 foot force main will help meet the wastewater treatment needs in west Bellevue and Bellevue's central business district for the next 50 years. Construction will begin in August.



County engineers will access

this property intermittently during the weeks of July 9 and July 16 to begin survey work related to the force main project. The work does not require entry to residences, but will require county contractors to work near the foundation of buildings at this address.

### **Work Schedule**

#### Week of July 9

Engineers will establish monitoring points on or very close to buildings at this address. In some cases, small holes about one-half inch deep may be drilled into the foundation of residences to insert small surveying markers. These markers are necessary to accurately monitor soil conditions throughout the force main installation, and pose no threat to a foundation's integrity.

### Week of July 16

Surveyors will return to this address to take readings using the monitoring points installed during the week of July 9.
