Notice to Residents Pump Station Site Clearing This Week

King County has contracted with Frank Coluccio Construction Company (FCCC) to construct the new Hidden Lake Pump Station, located at the corner of 10th Avenue Northwest and Innis Arden Way in Shoreline.

FCCC will begin by removing the trees around the existing Hidden Lake Pump Station and clearing the site to make room for materials and equipment. Tree removal is necessary to make room for construction of the new station and allow King County operators access to the existing station, which will remain in operation during construction. In addition, new pipes and utilities will be located beneath the existing trees.

What should you expect?

- Construction noise and activity will occur weekdays between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- Trucks and large equipment will be in the area. Look for directional signs and flaggers and use extra caution.
- Access to homes will be maintained.
- The construction area will be fenced and secured during non-working hours to protect children and pets.
- The contractor will re-landscape the pump station site with native vegetation at the end of construction.
