

**Common Themes from Murray CSO Control Project Community Design Workshop
October 29, 2011**

Approximately 20 community members attended over the course of the day. Common themes emerged for the project site design developed over the course of the morning session's discussion of community values and the afternoon's small group working session. These common themes (listed below) informed the specific design concepts developed by the small groups composed of community attendees and project team members:

Minimize "industrial facility" feel

- o Natural aesthetics
- o Use the natural topography, e.g. terrace the land or use the slope to hide/bury above ground structure(s)
- o Soft and minimal lighting
- o Minimal fencing

Encourage views of Puget Sound

- o Short trees
- o Open space
- o Overlook over green space, beach, and Sound

Discourage through traffic down Beach Drive

- o Curb bump-outs along Beach Drive
- o Pedestrian cross-walks across Beach Drive
- o Narrowing street from Lincoln Parkway entrance to Beach Drive
- o Re-configuration of the intersection at north end of site to "soften" the intersection

Enhance continuous space between Lowman Beach Park and land across the street

- o Improve access to the park --make Beach Drive a "portal to the parks"
- o More lawn
- o Maintenance access at southern right-of-way
