



Construction Update – October 19, 2017

King County's contractor will soon begin construction at the intersection of Frontage Road North and Ellingson Road in Algona

Construction duration, hours and timing

- **Work is anticipated to start October 23 and last 2-3 weeks.**
- Most work will occur nightly from 7 pm to 5 am, Monday through Friday, with limited Saturday work; also, limited work may occur between 9 am and 2 pm.
- Work will be conducted at times that avoid morning and evening rush hours.
- Work within Ellingson Rd. will be done in two phases (see map). Each phase will impact traffic flow but two-way traffic will be maintained at all times.

What to expect during work

- Access to businesses will be maintained, though it may be temporarily modified. Crews will place "business open during construction" signs in the area.
- Parking may be restricted in or near the work areas; please adhere to posted "no parking" signs.
- Cones, flaggers and signs will be used to direct traffic around the construction area.
- All lanes will be open outside of work shifts, including during morning and evening rush hours.
