

Project update: 5/18/16

We have come to a major milestone on the project: construction activities are beginning this week on the *Bayview portion of the project*. As a reminder, a new sewer pipe will be installed near the intersection of Rainier Ave. S. and S. Bayview St. to send sewage and stormwater from a pipe that gets full during storms to another pipe that has more room. Click here for a map of the project location.

The first activity you will notice is the removal of the small building between the Bartells and Mutual Fish on Rainier Ave S. Additional work that includes some lane closures on Rainier Avenue S and S Bayview Street will begin shortly afterwards. Lane closures of longer than 30 minutes will be done during the weekend hours listed below. Updates about this work and next steps will be provided as construction progresses.

Work hours for this part of the project:

- Regular work hours fall between 7:00 AM and 3:30 PM Monday through Friday.
 Work that alters traffic in Rainier Ave. S. for less than 30 minutes (e.g. traffic
 may be stopped while a truck backs into a driveway) may take place during
 regular work hours.
- Weekend hours: work in Rainier Ave. S. and S. Bayview St. will only occur between 5:00 PM on Saturday evening and 2:00 AM on Monday morning. During weekend hours, traffic may be reduced to one lane.
