

## Upcoming closures of Rainier Avenue South associated with weekend work between South College Street and 25th Avenue South

April 15, 2017

Starting as soon as April 22nd, King County contractors will begin weekend work on the Bayview portion of the Rainier Valley Wet Weather Storage Project. Weekend work will continue through mid-June but will not take place on Memorial Day weekend.

*During some portions of this work, Rainier Avenue South will be closed in both directions between South College Street and 25th Avenue South. See map on reverse side.* 

### What to expect:


- Work will begin after 5:00 PM Saturday evenings and end by 2:00 AM Monday mornings.
- If a closure of Rainier Avenue South is needed, traffic will be detoured to South College Street and 25th Avenue South.
- Increased noise and vibration.
- Businesses along Rainier Avenue South will be open during their regular operating hours.
- The work and schedule is weather dependent.

### About the Wet Weather Storage project:

King County's pipes in Rainier Valley and elsewhere send sewage and stormwater to a treatment plant in Magnolia to be cleaned. Pipes in the northern Rainier Valley get too much stormwater during storms and spill into the Duwamish River. These spills are called "Combined Sewer Overflows" or CSOs. King County is building new pipes and a new 340,000 gallon storage tank to hold the sewage and stormwater until it can be treated. This project will reduce the number of overflows to 1 per year on average. There are two parts to the project:

- 1) A **new sewer pipe** near the intersection of Rainier Avenue South and South Bayview Street will send sewage and stormwater from a pipe that gets full during storms to another pipe that has more room.
- 2) A **storage tank** at the intersection of South Hanford Street and South 27th Avenue will hold any remaining extra sewage and stormwater until the storm has passed.
