<p>Requirements</p> <p>To register to vote in Washington, you must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A citizen of the United States; • A legal resident of Washington State; • At least 18 years old by Election Day; and • Not under the authority of the Department of Corrections. <p>How to register</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register online with the Secretary of State, www.vote.wa.gov. • Download a registration form from the King County Elections website and return it by mail. • Register in person at the King County Elections office or annex. <p>Registration deadlines</p> <p>While you may register to vote at any time, there are registration deadlines prior to each election. The deadlines for the February 9, 2016, special election:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • January 11 – Deadline to register to vote online or by mail, or update existing voter registration information. • February 1 – In-person registration deadline for people not currently registered in Washington. Register in person at the Elections office in Renton or at the Voter Registration Annex in Seattle. <p>Keep your voter registration current</p> <p>Update your registration if you have moved or changed your name, or if your signature has changed.
