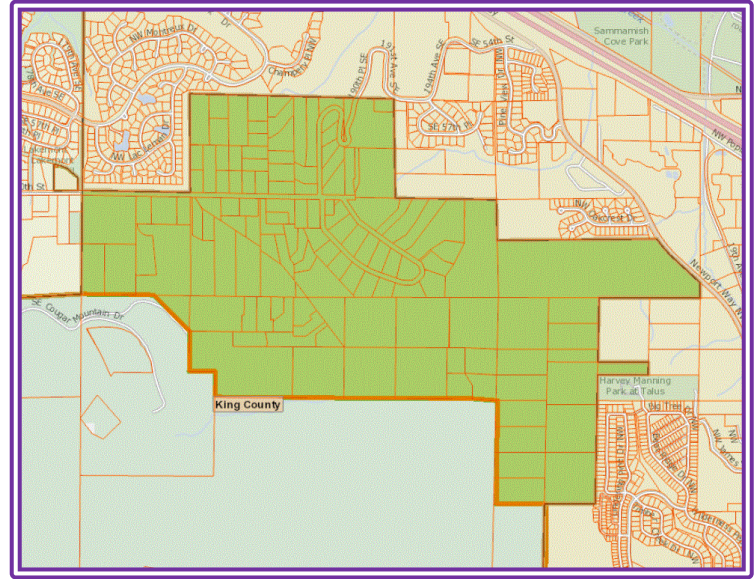
## Overview of Meeting:

On December 8, 2015, the City of Issaquah submitted a letter to King County requesting that **the East Cougar Mountain area be removed from the City's Potential Annexation Area (shown in dark green on map)**. Were this to occur, the land use on all or a portion of these properties would change from urban to rural.

King County is currently updating its Growth Management Act Comprehensive Plan and is hosting a public meeting to **solicit community input** on this request.

The meeting will include brief presentations from King County and the City of Issaquah, with the majority of the time set aside for oral and written comments. Comments will be accepted on this request until **February 3, 2016**.

A recommendation on this request will be included in the Executive Recommended Draft 2016 Plan when it is transmitted to the County Council on March 1, 2016
