

COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

Whereas King County has ^{competitively bid for} ~~negotiated~~ on-going agreements with vendors for supplies and equipment;

And Whereas King County and its vendors are willing to extend the terms of such agreements to the City of Duvall;

And Whereas the City of Duvall desires to have the ability to take advantage of the beneficial terms offered in said agreements;

Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 39.34, the parties agree as follows:

1. King County shall extend to the City of Duvall to the extent agreed upon by King County's vendors, the terms and conditions of King County's contracts for supplies and equipment. King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the contracts by the vendors nor for the payment of the purchase or lease by the City of Duvall.

2. The City of Duvall shall effect any purchases by a purchase order from the City directly to the vendor.

3. This agreement shall not relieve the City of Duvall from compliance with laws and regulations governing its purchases of supplies and equipment. Any purchase of supplies or equipment under this contract in excess of \$7500.00 and any public works improvement purchases shall be reviewed by the City Attorney prior to the issuance of a purchase order.

4. This agreement will be administered by the King County Executive's office through an authorized representative and by the City of Duvall's Mayor's office through an authorized representative.

5. This agreement does not create a new body that will hold any property pursuant to the agreement.
