Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

In accordance with King County Code 4.16.110, King County and Eastside Fire and Rescue agrees to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various medical supplies and equipment using King County's competitively awarded contract.

King County therefore extends the use of its contract to Eastside Fire and Rescue to the extent provided by the law and upon the following terms:

- (1) Whereas the vendor has agreed to extend to Eastside Fire and Rescue the terms and conditions of King County's contract which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- (2) Eastside Fire and Rescue accepts the terms and conditions of King County's contract with the vendor.
- (3) Eastside Fire and Rescue accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchase by Eastside Fire and Rescue shall be effected by a purchase order from Eastside Fire and Rescue and directed to the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (5) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by Eastside Fire and Rescue.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.
