In accordance with Chapter 39.34 RCW, King County and the City of Issaquah agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various equipment and supplies using King County's competitively awarded contracts.

King County therefore extends the use of its contracts to the City of Issaquah to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:

- (1) The vendor(s) agree to extend to the City of Issaquah the terms and conditions of King County's contract(s).
- (2) City of Issaquah accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchases by the City of Issaquah shall be effected by a purchase order from the City of Issaquah and directed to the vendor.
- (3) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by the City of Issaquah.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.

INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

§ 10004.14

Pursuant to Chapter 39.34 RCW Interlocal Cooperation Act and to other provisions of law, the King County Purchasing Department and the following named municipal, political or other public agency of the State of Washington, City of Issaquah hereinafter called the political agency, hereby agree to cooperative governmental purchasing upon the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The Department of Purchasing in contracting for the purchase of goods and services for King County, agrees to contract also on behalf of the political agency to the extent permitted by law and agreed upon by the parties.
- (2) The Department of Purchasing will contract for the purchases of goods and services according to the laws and regulations governing purchases by and on behalf of King County. The political agencies accept responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing purchases by or on behalf of the political agency in question.
- (3) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance or payment of the purchase price of any item or items contracted for by the political agency as a result of this agreement.
- (4) This agreement is for ONE (1) Self-Propelled Street Sweeper.
- (5) Duration: 7-08-93 to 7-08-94 or as provided by contract terms.
