In accordance with Chapter 39.34 RCW, King County and the Issaquah School District, No. 411 agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various equipment, supplies and services using King County's competitively awarded contracts.

King County therefore extends the use of its contracts to the Issaquah School District, No. 411 to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:

- (1) The vendor(s) agree to extend to the Issaquah School District, No. 411 the terms and conditions of King County's contract(s).
- (2) Issaquah School District, No. 411 accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchases by the Issaquah School District, No. 411 shall be effected by a purchase order from the Issaquah School District, No. 411 and directed to the vendor.
- (3) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by the Issaquah School District, No. 411.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.

INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

Resolution No. 971

A resolution of the Issaquah School District No. 411 authorizing the Superintendent to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with King County to engage in the cooperative procurement of various equipment, supplies and services.

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 RCW provides, in part, that "any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action;" and

WHEREAS, in the past, the Issaquah School District No. 411 has worked collectively with other public entities in Washington State; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Issaquah School District No. 411 has determined that these cooperative efforts have been of benefit to the District; and



WHEREAS, the District desires to enter in a cooperative relationship with King County for the procurement of various equipment, supplies and services; and
