Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

In accordance with King County Code 4.16.110, King County and Kirkland Fire Department agrees to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various medical supplies and equipment using King County's competitively awarded contract.

King County therefore extends the use of its contract to Kirkland Fire Department to the extent provided by the law and upon the following terms:

- (1) Whereas the vendor has agreed to extend to Kirkland Fire Department the terms and conditions of King County's contract which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- (2) Kirkland Fire Department accepts the terms and conditions of King County's contract with the vendor.
- (3) Kirkland Fire Department accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchase by Kirkland Fire Department shall be effected by a purchase order from Kirkland Fire Department and directed to the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (5) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by Kirkland Fire Department.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.
