Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

In accordance with King County Code 4.16.110, King County and Mercer Island Fire Department agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various medical supplies and equipment using King County's competitively awarded contract.

King County therefore extends the use of its contract to Mercer Island Fire Department to the extent provided by the law and upon the following terms:

- (1) Whereas the vendor has agreed to extend to Mercer Island Fire Department the terms and conditions of King County's contract which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- (2) Mercer Island Fire Department accepts the terms and conditions of King County's contract with the vendor.
- (3) Mercer Island Fire Department accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchase by Mercer Island Fire Department shall be effected by a purchase order from Mercer Island Fire Department and directed to the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (5) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by Mercer Island Fire Department.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party.
