


COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

In accordance with RCW Chapter 39.34 and to other provisions of the law, The City of Seattle ("City") and King County ("County") hereby agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various supplies, materials, equipment and services, using the City's competitively awarded contracts. The following terms and conditions apply:

1. The City, in contracting for the purchase of supplies, materials, equipment and services for the City, agrees, at its discretion, to extend said contracts to the County to the extent permitted by law, and agreed upon by the County and the vendor(s).
2. The County shall be responsible for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing purchases by or on behalf of the County.
3. Any purchases by the County shall be effected by a purchase order from the County and directed to the vendor(s).
4. The City shall not accept responsibility for the performance of any vendor contracted for by the County as a result of this Agreement.
5. The City shall not be responsible for the payment of any item(s) contracted for by the County as a result of this Agreement.
6. This Agreement shall continue in force until canceled in writing by either party.



JOINT PURCHASE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN CITY OF SEATTLE AND KING COUNTY
PURSUANT TO RCW 39.34, INTERLOCAL COOPERATION ACT

Terms of Agreement

1. City of Seattle and King County desire to participate in a joint purchase agreement for the purpose of purchasing or acquiring goods and services under one or more contracts of King County or City of Seattle established by bid procedure so as to enable the other party to purchase or acquire goods or services based upon said contracts.

2. "Purchasing Agency" and "Purchaser" are defined to mean the party for whose use the property is actually acquired.

3. The method of financing or payment shall be through budgeted funds or other available funds of the purchasing agency. Any services or goods procured by the purchasing agency under these contracts shall remain the exclusive property of or under control of said purchaser.

4. This agreement is expressly made under the provisions of Chapter 39.34 RCW, as a memorandum of understanding, in contemplation of further agreements between the parties relating to specific purchases as needs arise. Both parties understand and agree that contracts with vendors pursuant to this agreement may include purchases (a) by King County or City of Seattle acting as agent for either or both parties in securing the best bid price and terms on one or more items or kinds of property for a time period specified in such contract, under RCW 39.34.030 or 39.34.080, or (b) by King County or City of Seattle as agent for the other in procuring specific items of property, pursuant to a specific request made in writing by the purchaser, under RCW 39.34.080, or (c) joint purchase agreements relating to one or more specific items of property, pursuant to RCW 39.34.030.

It is further understood that in all such cases the party making such purchase will comply with purchasing statutes and applicable bid requirements.

5. This agreement shall remain in force until cancelled by either party in writing.

6. The administrative contact at City of Seattle will be the City of Seattle Purchasing Agent. The administrative contact with King County will be the King County Purchasing Agent.

7. Any personal property acquired through the use of this contract will be paid for, held and used by the purchasing agency until the time such property is of no further value or use to the purchaser, and at that time, it will be disposed of as required by the laws then in effect governing such disposal.
