

## Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

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In accordance with Chapter 39.34 RCW, King County and Sound Transit agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for the use of each others' competitively awarded contracts.

King County and Sound Transit therefore extend the use of its contracts to the other to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:

- (1) The vendor(s) agree to extend to the terms and conditions of contract(s) to the other agency.
- (2) King County and Sound Transit each accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Orders with contractors shall be completed by each agency directly with the contractor.
- (3) Neither King County nor Sound Transit accepts responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (4) Each agency is responsible for payment of the purchase orders they issue.
- (5) Each agency shall comply with their own respective procurement procedures for approval and execution of each purchase under this cooperative purchasing agreement.

This agreement may be revoked at any time in writing by either party. This agreement is effective upon execution for one year thereafter and renewed automatically each year thereafter unless terminated by either party.
