

Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

In accordance with Chapter 39.34 RCW, the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various equipment, services, and supplies under King County's competitively awarded contracts.

King County therefore extends the use of its contracts to WDFW to the extent provided by law and upon the following terms:

- (1) The vendor(s) agree to extend to WDFW the terms and conditions of King County's contract(s).
- (2) WDFW accepts responsibility for compliance with any additional of varying laws and regulations governing its purchases. Any purchase by WDFW shall be effected by a purchase order from WDFW and directed to the vendor.
- (3) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contract(s) by the vendor(s).
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by WDFW.

This agreement may be revoked at any time by either party.

Any purchases by the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall be effected by a purchase order from the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife and directed to the vendor.
- (3) King County accepts no responsibility for the performance of any of the purchasing contracts by the vendor.
- (4) King County accepts no responsibility for payment of the purchase price by the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife.


