Summary of Engineering and Planning (E&P) Subcommittee September 1, 2016 for MWPAAC General Meeting on October 26, 2016 Meeting

Task Force for I/I Strategy Assessment

This month, King County will be advertising a Request for Proposals for the infiltration/inflow program evaluation. This topic on this month's E&P agenda was intended to identify a small group of E&P members who would like to be on a task force for meeting periodically with the selected consultant and King County staff during the year-long project. The frequency and length of meetings would be determined once the consultant is selected. It was envisioned that the task force would report periodically to E&P as the study progressed.

Since most E&P members expressed an interest in participating on the task force, the E&P Subcommittee is re-evaluating whether to form a task force, or to have periodic work sessions with King County staff and the consultant as the project progresses. Once King County receives the proposals, we will re-evaluate the best way for MWPAAC to be involved in this project.

Status of Conveyance System Improvement (CSI) Update and I/I Program

King County staff continued the discussion of the CSI Update document that was discussed at the August meeting. The document describes conceptual projects that have been developed to address capacity needs in the separated portion of the regional wastewater conveyance system. King County staff plans to meet with local agencies where the proposed projects will be within their service area to review any concerns or opportunities for coordination with local agency projects.
