**SUBJECT: Presidential Visit July 22, 2014**

King County International Airport/Boeing Field (KCIA) will be the host airport while the President of the United States visits Seattle on Tuesday, July 22, 2014. **Please be aware of and monitor VIP Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) for Seattle and surrounding airspace.** Please ensure all employees and visitors on your leasehold have appropriate airport identification or are under direct escort by badged personnel.

In addition, the following restrictions and/or closures are on Tuesday, July 22.

- **Utility Runway 13L/31R** closed 1500L-1930L. It will be available for ground vehicles and fuel trucks only during non-ramp freeze times. Escorts will be provided by Airport Operations.
- **Taxiway Alpha** between A2 and A4 taxiway intersections closed 1500L-1930L.
- **Airport Terminal Gates 1-5** closed from 1200L-1930L.
- **Vehicle service “zipper” road** is closed between A2 and A4 1500L-1930L.
- **Additional aircraft and vehicle ramp parking** restrictions will be in place between American Avionics and Portland Street from 1200L-1930L.
- **Perimeter Road South** will be closed between the main Terminal Exit and Portland Street from 1600L-2000L.

Lastly, on Tuesday, July 22 from 1500L-1530L and 1900L-1930L the Airport is “frozen”, which means:

- All hangar doors must be closed.
- No one is to be airside on foot or in vehicles.
- No one is to be on any rooftops.
- **All airside activity must stop between these times.**

**All times are subject to change.**
