National Association of Counties Appoints Wilson to Key Committees

Wilson Named Vice Chair of Finance, Pensions and Intergovernmental Affairs Steering Committee, and appointed to Immigration Reform Task Force.

The President of the National Association of Counties (NACO) has appointed King County Assessor John Wilson to two key committees. Wilson will serve as a Vice Chair of the Finance, Pensions & Intergovernmental Affairs Steering Committee which reviews and develops NACO's position on all matters pertaining to the financial resources of counties, fiscal management, federal assistance, municipal borrowing, county revenues, federal budget, federal tax reform, elections and Native American issues.

In addition, Wilson was appointed to serve on the Immigration Reform Task Force which advises NACo's policy steering committees on immigration matters and engages on these matters with federal agencies and coalition partners.

Wilson remains a member of the Large Urban County Caucus, and the Information Technology Standing Committee
