II. Funding Structure:

2021-2022 MIDD Behavioral Health Services in Rural King County (SI-02)

In the 2021-2022 biennium, approximately \$680,000 is available through the MIDD funded initiative to support behavioral health services in rural and unincorporated areas in King County. Applicants may apply for up to \$85,000 per year for a total of \$170,000 for the 2021-2022 biennium.

2021-2022 MIDD Community-Driven Behavioral Health Services (SI-01)

In the 2021-2022 biennium, approximately \$700,000 is available through the MIDD funded initiative to support community-driven and responsive behavioral health services in King County. Of these funds, \$600,000 will be made available via 2 funding levels described below, and \$100,000 will be leverage through mini grants.

- 1. Opportunity 1 (O1): Small Grants (up to \$24,999 per year and up to \$49,999 per 2 yea project) up to 6 awards.
- 2. Opportunity 2 (O2): Mid-Size Grants (up to \$49,999 per year and up to \$99,999 per 2-year project) up to 3 awards.

III. Period of Performance

The period of performance of all awards resulting from both RFPs is tentatively scheduled to begin January 20, 2021, and to end on December 31, 2022.
