



- _ Integrate custom gutter as educational feature











MATERIAL PALETTE: WALLS




- Concrete Masonry Unit (CMU)

- _ Acoustic isolation




MATERIAL PALETTE: ROOF




- _ Metal roof
- _ No glare from views above
- _ Durable
- Low maintenance
- _ Long life span
- _ Reflect heat




MATERIAL PALETTE: RAIN GUTTER

- _ Bring natural light inside
- Reduce need for artificial light
