We are writing to you to invite you to drop in at an informal get together to learn about King County's design for the South Magnolia Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project. As you may already know, a portion of this project will be constructed on 32nd Avenue West.

On Saturday, January 26th, 2013, from 10 a.m. to 12 noon, we will meet with interested project neighbors and community members on the west side of 32nd Avenue West, south of the Howe Street Bridge. We are inviting you and your neighbors to attend to learn more about construction, which is scheduled to begin in late 2013. Our team will be on hand to walk you through the construction options for 32nd Avenue West, tell you how we will address potential impacts, and hear your thoughts and concerns.

We are holding this briefing outdoors at the location where work will occur in hopes it will be convenient for you to attend. We will provide light refreshments including hot coffee and cocoa.
