# 8. Substitute R&R No. BOH07-01.2

An amendment for the protection of the public health through the nutrition labeling of food; adding new sections to the Code of the King County Board of Health, BOH Chapter 5.10; enacted pursuant to RCW 70.05.060, including the latest amendments or revisions thereto.

Donna Oberg, Public Health Project Manager for Nutritional Options in Restaurants, briefed the Board on the substantive provisions of R&R BOH07-01. Roman Welyczko, Enforcement Coordinator, reviewed the proposed legislation.

Dr. Fleming clarified the intent of the regulation regarding delis in grocery stores. The regulation applies to establishments where menu items are served and there are places to eat, but not to deli items sold on a weight basis or where a person can choose the amount of the food purchased.

Jane McKenzie, Senior Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, outlined the facts of the pending lawsuit on menu labeling in New York City.

Carrie Cihak, lead staff to the Board, reviewed amendments M1 through M8 to the regulation.

Boardmember Hutchinson moved amendment M1. The motion passed by a vote of 12 to 0, Boardmember Dunn excused.

Boardmember Clark moved amendment M2. The motion passed by a vote of to 12 to 0, Boardmember Dunn excused.

Boardmember Hutchinson moved amendment M3. The motion passed by a vote of 12 to 0, Boardmember Dunn excused.

# 9. R&R No. BOH07-02

An amendment for the protection of the public health through the regulation of foods containing artificial trans fat; adding new sections to the Code of the King County Board of Health, BOH Chapter 5.10; enacted pursuant to RCW 70.05.060, including the latest amendments or revisions thereto.

Roman Welyczko, Enforcement Coordinator, reviewed the proposed legislation.

There was a discussion about whether the regulation would apply to hospitals, senior centers and nursing homes. Staff responded that only facilities regulated by the Department of Public Health are covered by the regulation.

Carrie Cihak, council staff, reviewed amendments F1 through F3.

Boardmember Lambert moved amendment F1. The motion passed by a vote of 11 to 0, Boardmembers Dunn, von Reichbauer and Hutchinson excused; Boardmember Gossett voting as an alternate.

Boardmember Lambert moved amendment F2. The motion passed by a vote of 11 to 0, Boardmembers Dunn, von Reichbauer and Hutchinson excused; Boardmember Gossett voting as an alternate.

Boardmember Ferguson moved amendment F3. The motion failed by a vote of 2 to 9, Boardmembers Dunn, von Reichbauer and Hutchinson excused; Boardmember Gossett voting as an alternate.
