7. <u>09-B25</u> H1N1 (swine flu) update

Dr. Fleming, Director, Public Health - Seattle and King County, briefed the Board on the vaccine update for H1N1. He noted that the slow growing virus hampered rates of production which produced far less than projected. He stated that the priority with distribution to the medical providers will continue. He stated that while the shortage of vaccine will continue for the next couple of weeks and months, there will be enough vaccine. Dr. Fleming stated when the supply increases, distribution to pharmacies will begin. He also noted that the anti-viral medication stock piled by the county is being released from our distribution center and there should be no problem of a shortage of supply. He did note a shortage in pediatric suspension, a medication for children around the country and it is being released from the CDC stock pile for distribution. He concluded that a hotline was recently established staffed by medical professionals and the public interest was generating 1,000 calls a day.
