A RULE AND REGULATION relating to electronic smoking devices and unapproved nicotine delivery products and adding a new chapter to BOH Title 19; enacted pursuant to RCW 70.05.060 and 70.160.080, including the latest amendments or revisions thereto.

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Scott Neal, Tobacco Prevention and Control Program Manager, Department of Public Health, briefed the Board on electronic smoking devices and made a PowerPoint presentation.

The amendment failed by a vote of 4 Ayes (Boardmembers Manning, Nicola, Hutchinson and Licata) and 6 Noes.

Boardmember Manning suggested an amendment on page 5, line 98 insert "product" after "devices". The Chair considered as friendly and there was no objection. Boardmember Lambert did not offer amendment 2, which had been distributed to the Board.
