Boardmember Kohl-Welles introduced Susie Levy, the new Administrator for the Board of Health, and welcomed her to the Board of Health.

Boardmember Kohl-Welles reported that the State Board of Health adopted an emergency 120-day rule banning the sale of flavored vape products in our state. A letter in favor of the rule was submitted on behalf of the Board of Health. The Governor is expected to introduce governor-request legislation in the 2020 session to address the vaping crisis in our state.
