23	BE IT ADOPTED BY THE KING COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH:
24	SECTION 1. R&R 09-01, Section 1, as amended, and BOH 2.06.008 are each
25	hereby amended to read as follows:
26	Fee schedules - ((A))annual review and fee adjustment ((where costs of
27	providing services will increase by less than five percent or decrease)) - notice -
28	periodic in-depth analysis.
29	((A. The board directs that the fees established in BOH Title 2 for issuing or
30	renewing licenses or permits or for such other services shall be reviewed by the director
31	of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health annually to determine, based on
32	and consistent with the annual budget adopted by the King County Council, whether the
33	cost of providing-services will increase by less than five percent of the cost of providing
34	services during the current year. If the director determines that the cost of providing
35	services will increase by less than five percent of the cost of providing services during the
36	current year, the director shall reduce fees from the levels established in BOH Title 2 so
37	that the fees for services shall not exceed the actual cost of providing the services. If the
38	director determines that the cost of providing services will increase by less than five
39	percent of the cost of providing services during the current year, the director shall reduce
40	fees from the levels established in BOH Title 2 so that the fees for services shall not
41	exceed the actual cost of providing the services. If the director determines that the cost of
12	providing service will be less than the amounts established herein due to but not limited

to, a reduction in the PERS contribution rate, the director shall reduce fees from the levels established in BOH Title 2 by an amount equivalent to the reduction in actual costs. This authority does not include the authority to adjust penalties established by the board. B. The director shall report in writing to the board any reduction in fees by December 15 before the year the reduced fees are to take effect. The director shall also report to the board on any reduction in fees at the next regularly scheduled or special meeting of the board after December 15.)) A. The board shall, in accordance with RCW 70.05.060, establish fee schedules for issuing or renewing licenses or permits or for such other services as are authorized by the law and the rules of the state Board of Health. The fee schedules shall not exceed the actual cost of providing any such services, which may include the cost of building fund reserves in accordance with any applicable county fund reserve policies. B. The director of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health shall annually review whether the fee schedules need to be adjusted to reflect the projected subsequent year costs of providing services, taking into account the budget adopted by the King County Council for the agency charged with providing such services. C. The director may annually adjust any or all fees up or down to reflect actual costs up to an amount that represents the most recently adopted Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton Area Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers, CPI-W, inflation forecast for the subsequent year prepared by the office of economic and financial analysis plus one percentage point, up to a maximum of five percent over the

65	current fee, plus the cost of building rate reserves in accordance with any applicable

67	D. The director shall:
68	1. Report annually in writing to the board on the revenues and expenditures of
69	agencies providing the permitted services, any change in fees and the new fee schedules
70	by December 15 each year; and
71	2. Present any change in fees at the next regularly scheduled or special meeting
72	of the board on or after December 15.
73	<u>E.</u> The director shall post the ((amounts of any reduced)) fee((s in both written
74	and electronic form)) schedules for the subsequent year for inspection((, review)) and
75	copying by the public, including ((providing a copy, in writing or by electronic format, of
76	the fees to the clerk of the board and each member of the board of health and)) posting
77	the fee <u>schedules</u> on the Internet, ((on or before)) by no later than December 31.
78	F. The director shall conduct an in-depth analysis of the accuracy of the fee
79	schedules, efficiency and effectiveness of service delivery, and opportunities for fee
80	schedule reductions at least every five years, with the analysis occurring during a
81	midbiennium year. The director shall report on findings from the analysis to the board.

The owner or operator of a food establishment subject to the permit requirement of WAC 246-215-200 or Food Code Paragraph 8-301.11 shall pay to the health officer a food establishment permit fee as set forth in Table 1, based on the establishment type and the risk category for the establishment. Where more than one type of food establishment exists within or as part of another food establishment (for example, a bakery within a grocery store or a deli within a meat market), the owner or operator shall pay the permit fee for each applicable food establishment type; except that the owner or operator of a grocery store with no more than two checkout stands, a general food establishment with no more than two checkout stands and no more than twelve seats for customers for on-site consumption of food or a meat/fish market with no more than two checkout stands shall pay only the highest applicable risk category permit fee without being required to obtain a separate permit for each type of food handling activity at the establishment. For purposes of this section, "highest applicable risk category permit fee" means the fee corresponding to the highest risk category of food handling activity at the establishment.

The owner or operator of a food establishment subject to the permit requirement of WAC 246-215-200 or Food Code Paragraph 8-301.11 shall pay to the health officer a food establishment permit fee as set forth in Table 1, based on the establishment type and the risk category for the establishment. Where more than one type of food establishment exists within or as part of another food establishment (for example, a bakery within a grocery store or a deli within a meat market), the owner or operator shall pay the permit fee for each applicable food establishment type; except that the owner or operator of a grocery store with no more than two checkout stands, a general food establishment with no more than two checkout stands and no more than twelve seats for customers for onsite consumption of food or a meat/fish market with no more than two checkout stands shall pay only the highest applicable risk category permit fee without being required to obtain a separate permit for each type of food handling activity at the establishment.
