1 A RESOLUTION designating the order in which the vice-
2 chairs of the King County board of health may act in the
3 absence of the chair in 2009.

5 WHEREAS, on April 16, 2009, the King County board of health adopted
6 operating rules for the board through BOH R&R 09-04, and

7 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that the board shall designate
8 annually four vice-chairs, each representing one of the major categories of membership,
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that, in the absence of the chair, a
11 vice-chair will exercise the duties, powers and prerogatives of the chair, and

12 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that each year the board shall
13 designate by resolution the order in which the vice-chairs may act in absence of the chair,
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that the order of the vice-chairs
16 shall rotate annually;
