

FY2017 Ryan White CARE Act Part A funded programs:

Individual clients are eligible for Ryan White-funded services if they: • Documented as living with HIV, as confirmed by a primary medical provider or lab tests • Resident of King, Snohomish, or Island County • Living at or below 300% of Federal Poverty Level (approximately \$35,310.00 for a single person and \$60,270.00 for a family of three)

Services Available under the Ryan White Part A program: Case management programs are often the gateway to helping PLWH access other needed services, such as medical care, insurance, prescription drug programs, and a variety of medical and social services.
